

Corridor Study Alternative Concepts Identified

The development and analysis of operational and design alternatives for improving the Arapahoe Road Corridor from I-25 to Parker Road is underway. During earlier stages of the project, a thorough technical and public process was used to identify a wide range of improvement options. The options were then screened to eliminate those that were incompatible with desired corridor travel characteristics; caused unreasonable impacts to corridor communities, businesses and the environment; or were financially unfeasible due to unrealistically high implementation costs. The remaining options were then refined to provide more detail regarding physical improvements and operations, and to identify concepts that fulfill future corridor travel demands.

Currently, the refined concepts are being packaged into alternatives for further study. Analysis of these alternatives is underway, and preliminary alternatives and initial findings will be available for you to review at the third public meeting to be held on November 2nd. We hope you will attend this meeting to give us input on the preliminary operational and design alternatives.
